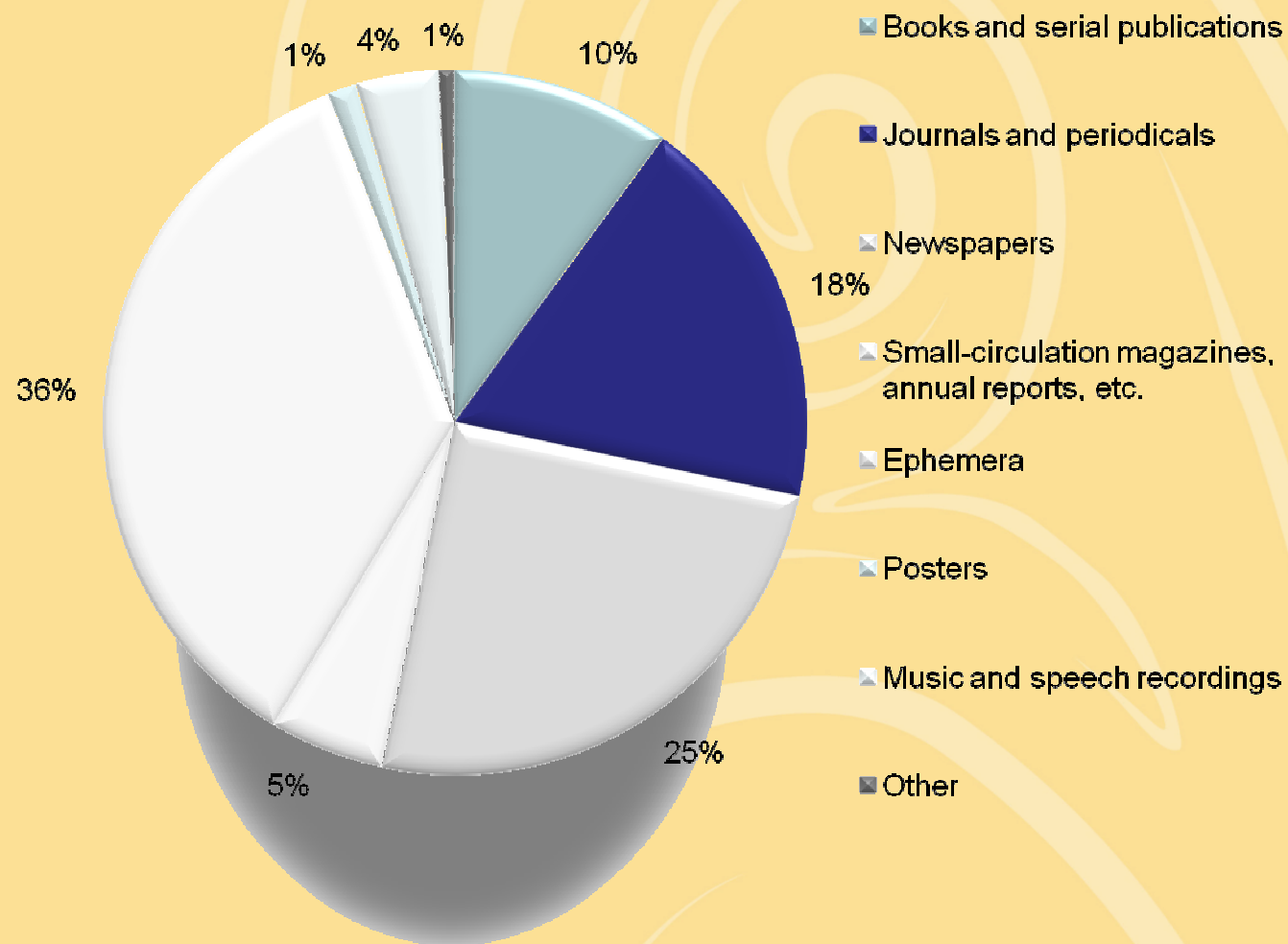

Quality requirements for national bibliographies

- high quality and completeness of records
- full coverage
- timely access to new records
- compliance with national and international standards
- continuity between retrospective and current bibliographies
- easy copying of records into local catalogues
- sophisticated searching and many access points
- links to local catalogues or full-text to enable access to publications sought
- verification of authorship and publication history
- give the statistical account of a country's publishing output

to promote publisher and bookstore cooperation and sharing of metadata

Goals and objectives e.g.

- optimise and expedite the production of metadata associated with a publication**
- expand the coverage of metadata, pre-publication metadata**
- facilitate the up-to-date delivery of metadata between various sectors**
- manage the continuous development and maintenance of standards**
- production of metadata according to common standards**
- technical capacity to control product information**
- electronic product information from the publisher to the ONIX-center**
- record platform as an open network service for the publishers**
